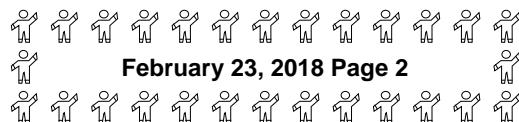

Again, thank you for entrusting your medical care with me.

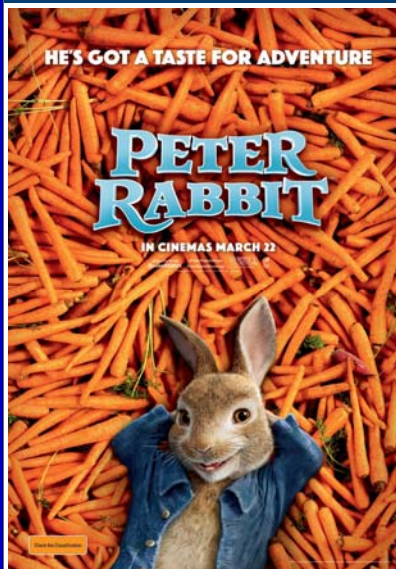

They sent out message to schoolmates that night, & the next morning they hauled the shirts to school in a plastic bag. As they stood in the foyer handing out the shirts, the bullied boy walked in. His face spoke volumes. 'It looked like a huge weight was lifted off his shoulders,' Mr. Price recalled. The bullies were never heard from again. I learned that two people can come up with an idea, run with it, & it can do wonders,' says Mr. Price, 17. 'Finally, someone stood up for a weaker kid.'" - Globe & Mail
