We have identified a transmission tower along the bank of the Bulkley River that is at risk of damage in the coming freshet. We are working with stakeholders to identify a date to make repairs which, for crew safety, will require the power be turned off to the communities of Telkwa, Smithers, New Hazelton, and Hazelton. Marine traffic on the Bulkley River in the work zone will need to be restricted for the safety of both the public and crews.




