The Toronto Blue Jays began their 48<sup>th</sup> season last week on March 29, defeating the Tampa Bay Rays. The Jays and the Seattle Mariners joined Major League Baseball as new members of the American League in 1977. Toronto and the Montreal Expos (1969-2004) were the only Canadian squads in the major leagues. The Jays beat the Chicago White Sox in their first game on April 7, 1977, a home opener at Toronto's Exhibition Park. A snowstorm swirled about the ballpark before play.



The team finished at the bottom of the AL East in each of its first five seasons. In 1985, Toronto won a first championship of any sort: the first of six AL East division titles. Two World Series titles in 1992 and 1993 remain the team's pinnacle. It was also in the 90s when Dave Stieb pitched the Jays' only no-hitter.

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 17 of the Woodlot Planning and Practices Regulation, that the Woodlot Licence Plan (2024-2034) for Woodlot Licence 1449, held in the name of Double A Ventures Ltd., has been prepared. The Woodlot Licence Plan area covers three parcels of land. Parcel A is located approximately 1 and 5 km on the Tea Lake FSR, Parcel B is located approximately 6 and 9 km on the Canoe Creek FSR, and Parcel C is located on the Kitwanga-Hazelton Backroad approximately 10km east of Kitwanga, British Columbia. The Kitwanga-Hazelton Backroad forms the south boundary of the woodlot and the Centre Nash-Y FSR forms the west boundary.

The Woodlot Licence Plan will be available for public viewing and comment from March 26, 2024 to April 26th, 2024 at the Hazelton District Public Library in Hazelton, B.C. The plan may be viewed during regular library hours at your convenience.

The Woodlot License Plan is governed by the Woodlot Planning and Practices Regulation and provides strategies and performance requirements for managing various resources and conserving and protecting non-timber resource values and features within the Woodlot License Plan area.



We have changed the doctor partnerships to keep the most consistent coverage for the clinic and the emergency room.
