Older Bulkley Browser readers will certainly remember The Beachcombers, a half-hour CBC TV "family adventure" program broadcast on Sunday nights after The Wonderful World of Disney from 1972-1990. The show developed out of another popular 1969 program called Adventures in Rainbow Country set near Ontario's Lake Huron and featuring an Ojibwa character named Pete. A change in CBC executives snuffed the series, but the suits at the network still liked the idea. A couple of years later they came up with The Beachcombers, shot in Gibsons, BC, which followed Nick Adonidis and his Sechelt First Nation first mate Jesse as they rounded up stray logs with their boat the Persephone to sell back to logging companies. Their rough-around-the-edges rival was Relic. They hung around the café Molly's Reach.



The show certainly wasn't the critics' choice, but it was Canadian must-see TV in the seventies, partially because there was very little choice during that decade. *The Beachcombers* is one of the most successful Canadian television series of all time, and is the country's second-longestrunning scripted television series. *The Beachcombers* was broadcast in more than 50 countries.
