

In the May 1979 Canadian Federal Election, Joe Clark was voted in as Prime Minister and the Conservative Party as the federal government. This brought an end to 16 years of government by the Liberal Party, including Pierre Trudeau as Prime Minister from 1968-1979. Nine months later a no-confidence vote forced another federal election, which the Liberals won. Trudeau served another four years as the head of state.



Remarkably, "Joe Who?" isn't the shortestserving Prime Minister. Two "caretaker" PMs after Clark, Kim Campbell (132 days in 1993) and John Turner (79 days in 1984), had briefer reigns in Ottawa. Charles Tupper holds the record: 68 days in 1896. Two years ago Liz Truss' tenure as British Prime Minister was 49 days.






