





LNG PIPELINE COMPRESSOR STATION



The Prince Rupert Gas Transmission pipeline plans to build 8 compressor stations – one near Utsun Creek on the Salmon River Road, 13 km northeast of Anspayaxw (Kispiox) village. This compressor station would operate 24/7 for 40 years, and would have 3 compressors, 3 generators, and 3 heat plants. Local air pollution would be 10 times greater than it is now. "Blowdowns" would vent pure methane, creating noise equivalent to a jet aircraft taking off. Compressor stations can catastrophically fail, leading to explosion and fire.
