With heavy hearts, we announce the passing of David Clifford Aspeslet, "Dave," on October 18, 2024, at the age of 91, surrounded by friends and family.

Born in Birch Hills, Saskatchewan, Dave was shaped by rugged landscapes and tough times. After arriving in Telkwa on a snowy night in 1947, he worked on the Chapman farm before becoming a miner, logger, farmer, and machinist—capable of running or fixing nearly any machine or piece of equipment.

In 1958, Dave married Bernice Lee, the love of his life, and together they built a family in the Kispiox Valley. His stories were legendary—whether chasing run away horses or daring to drive a Volkswagen Beetle up Thomlinson in the moon light—always told with a twinkle in his eye.

A devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather, Dave's greatest joy was his garden and his family. He leaves behind a legacy of grit, hard work, and the love of a good book or puzzle.

Dave is survived by his children Marney Wookey and Cindie Aspeslet, grandchildren Wanda Belisle, David Wookey, Lori Tiljoe, Kale Bellingroth, and Justin Aspeslet, and great-grandchildren Brianna, Peyton, Odin, Abigail, Alec, Ryder, Urijah, and Nolan.

The staff of the **Grace Lynn Centre** has been making sandwiches and buying fruit and granola bars for the 30 people who are OAT clients. This means the clients are receiving Opioid Agonist Therapy to help battle addiction. They see a Northern Health OAT nurse every day. About a year ago we were asked if we could provide a simple sandwich and a piece of fruit 4 days a week and fruit and granola bars for Fridays. The program started with 20 people and is now at 30 people. The food has been really helpful to the people experiencing addiction and we want to continue. We have received funding through the Wrinch Memorial Foundation and donations from Jocelyne McLean's comedy night proceeds, BVCU and RDKS, but this is still several thousand dollars short of what it takes to run this program for a year! We are looking for financial donations. We are looking for food donations of meat, cheese, mayonnaise, fruit and granola bars. We are getting some bread from the Skeena Bakery but could use more.

## **New affordable apartments renting soon in Hazelton**

### **Ama sii anjok “Good New Homes”**



HAZELTON - Seniors, families, individuals and people living with disabilities in the Upper Skeena area will soon have access to affordable housing as construction is nearing completion on 31 rental homes.

Located at 2720 Highway 62, across from the Hazelton High School and the new Upper Skeena Recreation Centre, the three-storey building will include one, two and three bedroom units, six of which are fully accessible. Other amenities include a modest multipurpose room, indoor bike storage and a laundry room. The grounds are landscaped with a well equipped playground to the south. All units will be equipped with standard kitchen appliances, with the larger units also including washers and driers.

To ensure affordability the building has 6 units with “deep subsidy” support, 15 units with “Rent Geared to Income” support and the remaining 10 homes with rents set at affordable market rates.

The Wrinch Memorial Foundation Society will manage the new building which is currently scheduled to be ready for occupancy in March. More details will follow in the next month or two, concerning the BC Housing application process, income testing, and the anticipated rent schedule.
