





Earth experienced a period known as the **Carnian Pluvial Event** about 232 million years ago when its landmass was clumped together in a supercontinent called Pangea. The CPE marked a dramatic turn in the planet's climate history. In an extraordinary shift, Earth transitioned from very dry conditions to a prolonged phase of intense rainfall that lasted over a million years.



The driver for this event was a massive volcanic explosion within the Wrangellia Large Igneous Province, an area of Pangea made up of today's south-central Alaska through the coast of British Columbia.
