

On August 31, 1925, Commander John Rodgers, US Navy, and his four-man crew attempted the first overseas flight from the mainland USA to Hawaii. It was anticipated to be a 28-hour voyage over 2,400 miles of open ocean. His flying boat PN-9 No. 1 was loaded with more than a thousand gallons of gasoline. Unfortunately, he ran out of fuel 450 miles short of his target, and after it was clear PN-9 No. 1 wasn't going to be located in the ocean, his crew rigged a sail to the plane and they all sailed to Hawaii.



By its arrival in Hawaii, the quintet was desperately low on food and water. Sand sharks, tiger sharks and barracuda followed them. The flying boat arrived in Kauai's Nawiliwili Harbor ten days after it left San Francisco, a submarine towing it through the final treacherous coral reefs.




