December 20, on this day in 1957 While spending Christmas as his new Tennessee Mansion Graceland, **Elvis Presley** received a draft notice for the U.S. Army. He was sworn into the army as a private on March 24, 1958, and after basic training, he sailed to Europe. Over the next 18 months he served in Company D, 32nd Tank Battalion, 3rd Armored Division in Friedberg, Germany, where he reached the rank of sergeant. The motor pool and tanks of Presley's unit's tanks were used in his 1960 movie "G.I. Blues". He received the Army Good Conduct Medal.

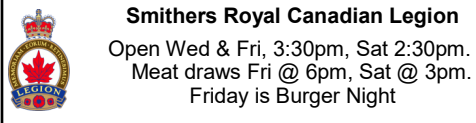
