



### 2025 Peace in Space

2025 is the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Apollo-Soyuz Test Project, the first international partnership between the American and Soviet space programs. Before the two Cold War rivals first met in orbit, such a partnership seemed unlikely, being proceeded by 30 years of

sabre-rattling, nuclear threat and proxy

wars between the two nations.

On July 15, 1975, an Apollo spacecraft launched carrying a crew of three astronauts (Slayton, Stafford and Brand) and docked two days later with a Soyuz spacecraft and its crew of two cosmonauts, Leonov and Kubasov. During nearly two days of joint activities, the quintet carried out five experiments and exchanged commemorative items. The astronauts even played the cosmonauts the song "Why Can't We Be Friends?", which was pretty hot in the States at the time. The successful Apollo -Soyuz Test Project paved the way for future international partnerships.


