## WHY PLUTO IS NOT A PLANET INFOGRAPHIC



In 2006 The International Astronomical Union (IAU) met to set the criteria for what could be considered a planet.

### 1. IT ORBITS THE SUN

The body must orbit the Sun, or the main star in its solar system.



Pluto meets this criteria as it orbits the Sun every 248 Earth years!



While Earth's Moon is about 30% bigger than Pluto, it orbits the Earth and not the Sun directly, so it is not a planet.

### 2. SUFFICIENT MASS

The body must have enough mass that gravity compresses it into a nearly round sphere.



Pluto meets this criteria! But with a diameter of less than 2,400 kms, it is smaller than some well-known moons in the Solar System.



This excludes things like asteroids. While many times they orbit the Sun directly, they are not large enough to have been gravitationally compressed into a sphere.

### 3. CLEARED ITS ORBIT

It must be big enough that it has cleared away any other objects of a similar size near its orbit around the Sun.



Pluto failed this criteria! Pluto orbits the Sun in the Kuiper Belt region of the Solar System, a crowded space with other objects of significant mass. Until it does, Pluto will be considered the largest of the Dwarf Planets.



**FACT:** Pluto's orbital path actually crosses Neptune's orbit! Though they are unlikely to ever collide, Pluto has failed to clear its orbit of significant competitors.
