





is the 100th anniversary of Art Deco design, introduced at the Exposition Internationale des Arts Décoratifs et Industriels Modernes in Paris. The style used in visual arts, architecture and product design is streamlined and geometric. Big bold shapes like starbursts, fans, zigzags and arcs are used as ornamentation in Art Deco. The style flourished in the 1920s and 1930s.



Some well-known examples of Art Deco architecture are the Empire State Building and the Chrysler Building in New York City (The Chrysler Automobile Corporation was also founded in 1925) and Vancouver's City Hall. Rio de Janeiro's huge, famous Christ the Redeemer stature is also Art Deco. Even Maple Leaf Gardens, or "Puckingham Palace", where the Toronto Maple Leafs played from 1931 to 1999, is Art Deco.

Coincidentally, F. Scott Fitzgerald published *The Great Gatsby* in the same month as the Paris exhibition. Art Deco and *The Great Gatsby* are both associated with the 1920s Jazz Age, along with flappers and the jazz music itself.

January 10, on this day in 1920, The League of Nations, a precursor of the United Nations, was established in Geneva following World War

I. The League of Nations was the first worldwide intergovernmental organisation whose principal mission was to maintain world peace. Canada was one of the 23 nations that joined the first day. The League failed to intervene following Japan's occupation of Manchuria in 1931 and the invasion of Abyssinia (Ethiopia) by Italy in 1935. This not only affected the political credibility of the League, but also marked the collapse of the collective security system. In 1933, Nazi Germany withdrew from the League. The United Nations replaced the League in 1946 following World War II.






